



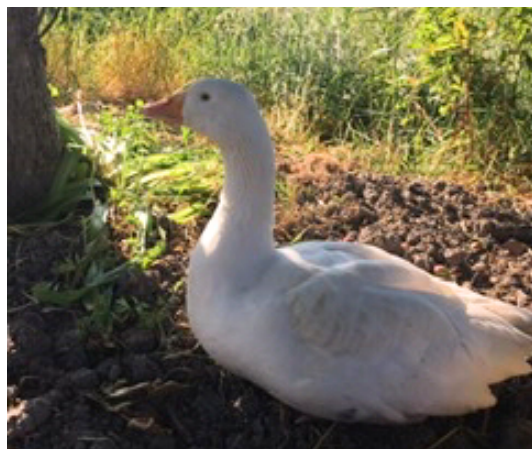
Level 2 in Work-Based Animal Care

This qualification is for individuals looking to advance their knowledge and skills in animal care. It provides hands-on experience of animal health, welfare, handling, and husbandry, whilst supporting the shift from working under supervision to a more independent role in a workplace. It's ideal for those passionate about animals who want a rewarding profession.

HOW IT WORKS

This qualification is suitable for those with basic experience working with animals, looking to gain more knowledge. It can be set at three different levels; Award, Certificate or Diploma, which differ in complexity.

Guided Learning Hours (GLH) are the number of hours a learner needs in their placement to complete the qualification.

The GLH for this qualification are: 72-76 (Award), 158 (Certificate), 330-440 (Diploma). It can also be full-time or part-time.

As part of this qualification the following topics will be covered:

TEACHING AND SUPPORT

At the placement there will be fully qualified staff with in-depth experience working with SEND learners. A specialist Trainer Coach will also be available to assess the learning taking place and provide additional support. The qualification is achieved entirely through an evidence-based portfolio and no exams are required at any point.

FUNDING

This course is funded by the local authority for anyone from 16 – 25 years old with an Educational Health Care Plan (EHCP) within the catchment area, and is also available to those who may wish to consider paying privately.
